

- **Firearms (rifles, shotguns, and handguns)** are accepted as checked baggage only.
  - Firearms must be unloaded and transported in a specially designed case.
  - A firearms declaration form must be completed and signed before Central Mountain Air will accept firearms for carriage.
  - Ammunition must be packed separately (max 5 kg or 11 lbs) and securely in a strong container of wood or fibreboard, plainly marked “ammunition”, or in the original container.
  - Extra charges may apply

- **Fishing Equipment:**

Fishing equipment such as rods, reels and tackle boxes are accepted as checked baggage only and must be secured in a safe case to provide adequate protection to the contents and to prevent damage to other baggage.

- **Perishable Items (fish, meat, antlers)**

Central Mountain Air accepts perishable items (fresh or frozen) including fish, meat, hides and antlers as checked baggage. These items must be properly packaged and cushioned.

- Perishable items must be packaged in a 100% leak-proof and impact-proof container. Styrofoam coolers will NOT be accepted.
- Any leaking items will be refused for transport.
- Only gel packs can be used for cooling.
- Perishables and antlers *are only accepted on CMA Dash 8 and Dornier 328 operated flights.*
- CMA does not accept liability for spoilage for any reason including delays.
- Arrangement of any ground transportation for perishable items is the customer’s sole responsibility.
- Perishables are accepted as part of your checked baggage allowance. Excess or overweight fees apply.
